

## ANNUAL MEADOW-GRASS

*Poa annua*



NOT AFFECTED by RESCUE

### Key identifiers

- Youngest leaf folded in shoot
- Tramlines on leaf
- Older leaves often 'crinkled in centre' ①
- Large ligule
- Inflorescence – Panicle. Often in flower in mown turf, even at very short heights of cut ②
- Susceptible to Fusarium Patch and Anthracnose



Can be confused with:

**Smooth-stalked Meadow-grass (page 19)** – look for large ligule, paler colour and leaf softness in Annual Meadow-grass
