All the easy to use GreenCast recording sheets are provided in two formats:

- pdf files that you can print off to complete manually and retain in a file.
- Microsoft Word document templates, for you to download, save and complete. You can add in your own establishment details and information if required. The record sheets can be saved direct onto your computer hard drive, or printed and retained. Computerised records should be regularly backed up onto a secure data record system for safety. The files are compatible with Word versions 2003 onwards.

Fill in the names and details of all your sprayer operators on this form and file at the front of your spray record file. When you complete the Spraying Record Sheet you need only insert the operator's reference number - 01; 02 or 03, for example - in the spray record sheet.

This form can be updated with qualifications attained and training courses attended by sprayer operators, as a record of continuous personal development.

Spraying Record Sheet

Use this sheet to record all turf spray applications, including details of areas treated, what was applied, when, why, weather conditions and any other additional details.

Give each Spraying Record Sheet a reference number, which can be cross referenced on the Spray Store Records of product use, for example 10-001; 10-002 etc.

If you download the template from GreenCast and save a new sheet for each application on your computer - including the sheet reference number in the file name - be sure to print out and file a copy for future reference.

Spray Store Records

Use this sheet to record all chemical purchases brought into store, where it was used (cross-referenced to the Spraying Record Sheet), how much is still in store and the appropriate disposal route for pesticide packaging.
